**RESULTS:** Other than the few mentions in the tax records that have already been uncovered, no mention of this family could be found in any of the sources checked. There are some families with related names, such as BRASHER and BISHOP, but none of these lists a Christopher/Christly/etc.

**NOTES:** The lack of records on the BISHIR family in Campbell County points to the fact that they were here, as has already been surmised, for only a very short time. As always, it is possible that additional recorded evidence of their time in Campbell County exists, but it has not come to light in this search. If new information becomes available in the future, and additional searches are desired, please be in touch. I will certainly be on the look-out for any mention of the surname as I conduct future research.
