Family File No. 7384 (BISHER): There are only three papers in this file.

1. A letter dated 28 Jan 1985 from Betty Low, RR2, Gwynne, Alberta T0C 1L0
The letter says she is inquiring about obtaining the birth record of her great-great
grandfather, Jeremiah BISHIR, born 13 June 1800 in York County (Covington)
PA.
2. A response to Betty Low dated 12 Feb 1985, from Roberta L. Hudson, Librarian
of the Historical Society of York County. This letter states that the society does
not answer reference requests by mail because of staff restraints. It advises her
that during that time period no birth records were kept and that her best bet would
be to try to get church and/or Bible records.
3. A copy of an obituary which reads: BISHER; on Mar 7, 1926 before 8 a.m. at his
residence on Laurel R.O. No. 1, John A. Bisher, aged 69 yrs. Relatives and
friends are invited to attend the funeral on Wednesday at the house at 10:30 a.m.
with services in the Gatchelville M.E. Church. Interment in adjoining cemetery.
4. An index card from tax records. I will attach a copy of this card.

I looked up the Gatchelville M.E. Church and found that it is located in Fawn Township,
in York County.

Because of the obituary which stated John A. Bisher was buried in the cemetery at the
Gatchelville M.E. Church, I looked for the Church/Cemetery records for Gatchelville. I
found a book, "Comprehensive Church Record of the Cross Roads Circuit and
Gatchelville", Prospect Methodist Episcopal Church; Baptisms 1904-1924; Marriages
1905-1923. I found only one record that was even close... a baptism:
26/03/1907; BISKER, John Melvin; b. 14/06/1904; PARENTS: Jas. W. & Agnes E.;
PLACE: Parent's; MINISTER: Hartman Shipe.

Family File No. 1264 (BISH):

1. Marriage document for 5 Oct 1845, William BISH to Susanna Baumgartner in Hanover, York County, PA, married by Jacob Albert, Minister of the Gospel. There is a very small copy of this marriage record which is not legible, but it has been transcribed below the picture.
2. There are notes typed from a German Bible; it says the Bible is printed by Maclean, Gibson & Co. in New York, 1872. The Bible was presented to the Historical Society of York County 12 Sept 1962 by Mr. Edwin W. Rupp, 293 West Cottage Place, York, PA.

Marriages: Philip Krumvine Wentz of West Manheim Township, York County, PA and Miss Eliza Alice, daughter of William H. and Susan BISH of the same place, on 20th of March 1873 by Rev. Daniel J. Hauer, D.D. at Hanover. Dr. Hauer was Pastor of the Ev. Lutheran Church of Manheim, York County, PA.

3. A copy of a certificate of confirmation of Eliza Ann BISH 2nd day of Oct 1869, P.P. Lane, Pastor of the St. Johns Evang. Lutheran Church in Littlestown, PA.
4. There is also an envelope full of newspaper articles on BISH/BISCH, but none seem to be related to our research.

Family File No. 1105 (BICHER, BECKER, BAKER): This is a VERY large file, which includes two large boxes of papers and newspaper articles (which I did glance through and saw mostly Baker things), and three boxes of index cards which include tax records, cemetery records, vital records, and estate records. I went through the index cards (which are in alphabetical order by given name) looking for Christopher, Christian, Jeremiah, and any other like given names. Below is what I found, but there is still no concrete evidence of any matches.
